PART 1 definition

STATEMENT OF INTENT

The Moleskine brand was created in 1997 with the intent of producing tools for self-expression, creativity and ideas. It was inspired by the legendary notebooks used by artists and literatures in the past two centuries, from Vincent Van Gogh and Pablo Picasso to Ernest Hemingway and Bruce Chatwin. The little black notebook is the primary product and has inspired iconic design elements with the clean and simple aesthetics. Today, the brand cross-fertilises the analogue creation and digital technology bringing together the traditional and the contemporary. The essence of Moleskine is to capture journeys, for this reason, this project will be centred on the notion of sharing journeys. It will be a space for inspiration, activity and collaborations. The minimalistic white and black aesthetic will be kept with the addition of brown wood to epitomise the idea of the old and the new as complimentary. An exhibition of participating artists at the 2017 V&A London Design Festival campaigning 'design is here, there and everywhere' will be showcased. There will be a dedicated space for workshop and creation with the opportunity to interact with the digital or analogue Moleskine tools. This project will present a clear understanding of the brand promise as well as collaborating with loyal creatives.

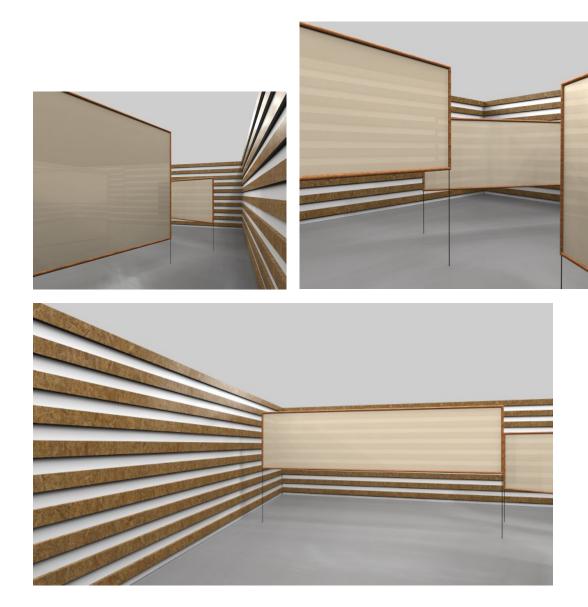

CONCEPT

DIGITAL/ANALOG

The room is split betwen two ideas. The digital aspect will be clean and minimalistic, only using black and white. The use of minimalistic black lines to create outlines of cubes will give it a digital look. This is modular and can be stacked in accordance to the layout of the room. The analog side will have a wooden texture implemented to give the sense of being surrounded by the traditional way of working -with pencil and paper.

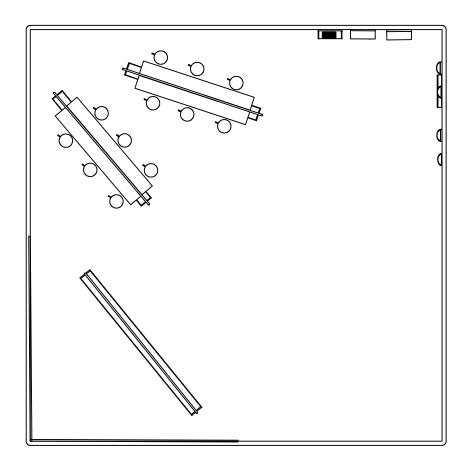

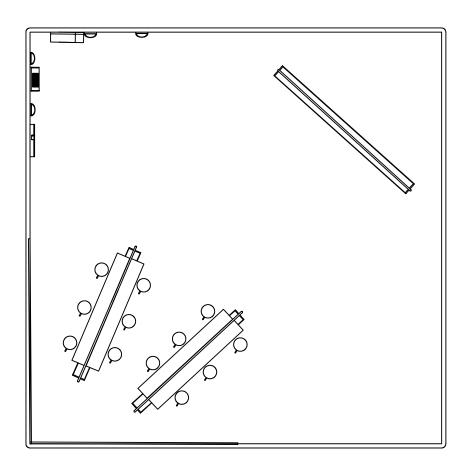

ALTERNATE PLANS

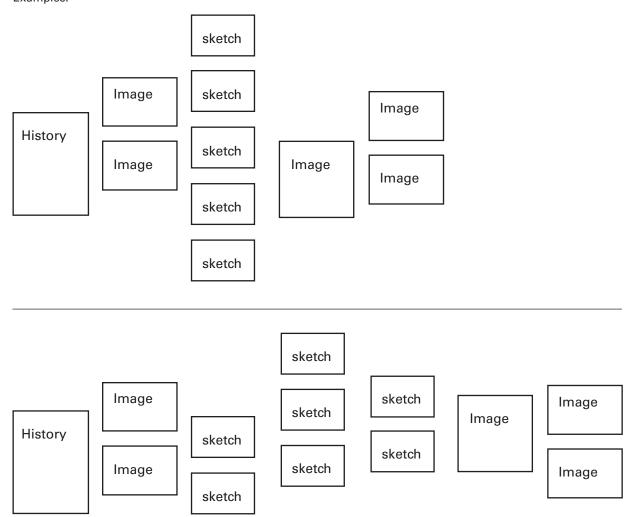


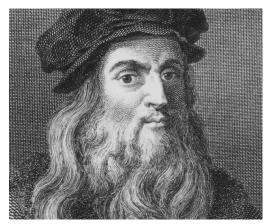

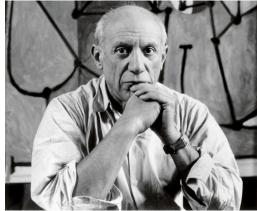
GRAPHIC LAYOUT

The history must be layed out by the entrance wall. The images are allowed to be split apart but must follow a pattern. Extra images and sketchbooks can be incuded.

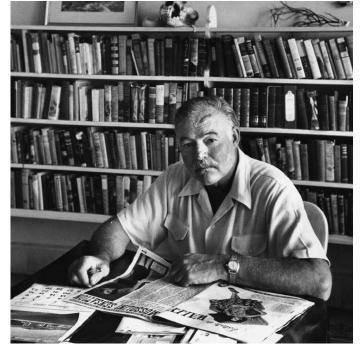
